Please place your recycling for collection, by the kerbside, before **7am** on the collection day, taking care not to cause any obstruction. Please make sure your recycling is clearly visible to the collection crew.

Some residents may have to place their recycling at a central collection point. The Council will have already notified you, if this is the case.

Please make sure all recycled materials are clean and free from food waste to avoid attracting wildlife and vermin. Please rinse and crush plastic bottles and cans as much as possible. There is no need to remove the labels. Please also flatten any cardboard as much as possible.

**Please only present recycling in the containers provided by the Council.**
